



The IQAC Committee took the following resolutions in the meeting (4/3/2017):

1. NAAC Preparation—It was resolved that recommendations made by the Peer Team during the 2nd Cycle of NAAC be reviewed in order to see where the college needs to make improvements. It was observed that the college did not have enough space for hostels and playgrounds for sports. But everything possible should be done to augment the strengths of the college.
2. Keeping the Students' feedback regarding sports in mind, it was resolved that the Sports Committee be encouraged to find ways to provide more opportunities for students to get involved in games and sports with some coaching assistance from local sportspersons if possible.
3. The college has to plan for present infrastructural requirements and for future expansion and upgradation of departments. The college needs to procure funds for the same RUSA being a viable option for getting such funds. The college should try that option.

Action taken on the resolution of 4/3/2017:

1. The report of the Peer Team was reviewed and the recommendations were identified and noted for future planning and implementation.
 - a. Additional land could be acquired for growth and development.
 - b. Urgent need for Staff vacancies to be filled up
 - c. Establish full-fledged Language lab to train students in Communicative English.
 - d. Expansion of Outdoor sports facilities with coaches for students
 - e. Expansion of IT lab with internet facilities for all students
 - f. UGC value add-on courses and skill development courses to be introduced.
 - g. Issues with environment ecology and solid waste management to be identified and students to be more engaged in their management.
 - h. Academic Audit may be conducted annually.
 - i. Enhancing intellectual capital through continuous research and publication in high impact journals.
 - j. Introduction of PG courses besides physical education and music at the undergraduate level

2. The sports committee to hold selection trials in compliance with the events planned in the college calendar for various outdoor sports and encourage students to participate in competitions.

3. Plans made to apply for RUSA grants for infrastructural development and purchase of equipment for science departments.

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

Resolution taken in the IQAC meeting of 5/5/2017:

1. a. According to the recommendations of the Peer Team, NAAC preparation to focus on areas identified. Since land acquisition, and creation of sports facilities are not feasible at present, other alternatives to be explored.
b. Teachers to be encouraged to continue research and publication.
c. Other areas identified besides the specific recommendations also to be improved. Mentoring Students and developing more student-centric approach to teaching.
d. Need to recommend that the college engage more part-time teachers especially in view of the impending change of academic system from annual to semesters.
2. The Annual Examination of the College is going on smoothly so far. Since the annual Examinations will be replaced by the semester system, the college should ensure that the current batches of students are given as much assistance as possible to clear their exams without back papers so that the transition to the new system becomes smooth and without impediments.
3. The worsening political situation may affect normal functioning and create problems. The college should be prepared with alternatives to stay in touch with students and carry out academic activities.





Resolutions taken in the IQAC Committee Meeting of 16/3/2018:

1. Annual Examinations this year would require more effort in management as students have been affected very badly by the 104-day strike in the Darjeeling Hills. It was resolved that the Examination Committee would be given additional assistance in conducting the examinations in a peaceful and controlled environment.
2. The fund of Rs. 70,00,000/- has been sanctioned by the Govt. of West Bengal through Memo No. 1183(SANC)/EHP/CS-6B-5/2015 in the financial year of 2016-2017 in Annexure 1183(SANC)/EHP/CS-6B-5/2015. The first work order was given in 6/3/2018. The order would take effect from 7/3/2017 and should be completed within 45 days. This fund would create a big staff-room for teachers with additional facilities, and a space for an auditorium. The extended facilities would be constructed on top of the main administrative building of the college. The state of the project as on the date of the meeting is still incomplete. The college needs to ensure that the project be completed as soon as possible so that the teaching staff would have a more spacious room to work in and the college have a bigger hall for holding college events.
3. The CBCS system is to be introduced this year. Since this will be a new system to be implemented in the colleges under NBU, the IQAC would have to guide the teaching and non-teaching staff to prepare for implementing the same. Since the subject combination for our college has to be worked out from the subject baskets given by the University, an additional small sub-committee should be entrusted to work out the details of both subject combination and the routine to be framed to accommodate both the old and new systems.

Action taken on the resolution of the IQAC Committee Meeting held on 16/3/2018:

1. After the Strike was lifted in September 2017, teachers took special effort to engage intellectually and emotionally with students in the classrooms. Staff meeting was held to discuss the Annual Exam. Teaching and Non-teaching staff were sensitized to the need to be extra vigilant and careful while dealing with the examinees during the exams as everyone has come through a lot of stress due to the politically hostile and traumatic experience during the 104-day strike. Strategies were discussed to tackle any difficulties that may arise during the exams.
2. The project for construction of staff-room and auditorium is still incomplete as it is being handled through the governmental system which calls for many formalities. It has also been affected by the political turmoil in the Darjeeling Hills. Efforts are on to resolve the delay.
3. A syllabus and routine sub-committee has been created to look after subject combination under the new CBCS system, and routine of the college accommodating both the old and new systems.



Resolutions taken on the IQAC Committee Meeting held on 1/6/2018:

1. After reviewing the progress made so far by the Admission Committee and the sub-committee looking after the subject baskets and routine, it is to be seen what will actually happen during the full implementation of the CBCS System. It was resolved that the Admission Committee be requested to make Power Point Presentations to orient the students to the CBCS System, especially to the subject charts that explain the subject combination in each semester.
2. It was resolved that IQAC assist teachers wherever necessary, to disseminate the curriculum and implement the new system and syllabus smoothly.
3. Sports activities would still remain a necessary priority for student engagement. The Sports Committee would be given encouragement to devise new strategies and channels to hone students' skills for various sports and games.

Action taken to implement the resolution of the IQAC Committee meeting of 1/6/2018:

1. Academic Committee, Admission Committee, and the routine sub-committee planned the implementation of the CBCS system and the curriculum. Subject Baskets were defined to work under the constraints of the ground realities of Kalimpong College. The committee also planned presentations for the newcomers to explain the CBCS system and the subject charts.
2. Teachers were encouraged to be prepared for the change in system, and to give emphasis on classroom teaching to be a good balance of subjects and student-centric approaches. Teachers were reminded to put organized mentoring of students into practice.
3. The Sports Committee decided to go ahead with the selection trials of Football, Volleyball, Table-tennis and Athletics.
